PLEASE READ SCHEDULE CAREFULLY

CONDITIONS:

1. Entries must have been taken by the exhibitor.
2. Entry forms and Photographs must reach the HUT B, St. Ives Showground by 5.00pm on Thursday 13th May 2021.
3. Print section entry tickets to be printed out when entering online. If unable to print please ask for them at the show office when dropping off your entries. Print section entry tickets to be attached to the Front Upper Right corner of each entry.
4. The name of the exhibitor must not appear on the face of the print. The information cards, available when entering MUST BE adhered securely to the back of the entered item. If unable to print please ask for them at the show office when dropping off your entries.
5. Any prize winning photographs exhibited in any previous St. Ives Show are not eligible for entry.
6. No framed photographs will be accepted. Please mount your photographs with a mount and backing board. No glass please.
7. Photographs must be no smaller than 13cm x 18cm (5" x 7") or 15cm x 10cm (6"x 4") in the Junior Section. Maximum size of any finished mount is to be 40cm x 50cm (16" x 20").
8. Exhibits may be collected on Sunday 16th May between 4:00pm & 5.30pm. Remaining entries will be available from the Show Office on after which remaining items will be disposed of unless prior arrangements have been made with the Chief Steward.
9. Exhibitors must present their nomination receipt to collect entries..
10. Exhibitors are not permitted to interfere with the judging process.
11. Provisions are made for awarding 1st, 2nd & 3rd place in each class. Judges may withhold any or all places if exhibits are not of an acceptable standard.
12. There is a limit of ONE entry per person due to space limitations.
13. The Society reserves the right to exclude from judging or display any exhibit which does not comply with the above conditions.
14. Every care will be taken of exhibits but no responsibility will be accepted for loss or damage.
